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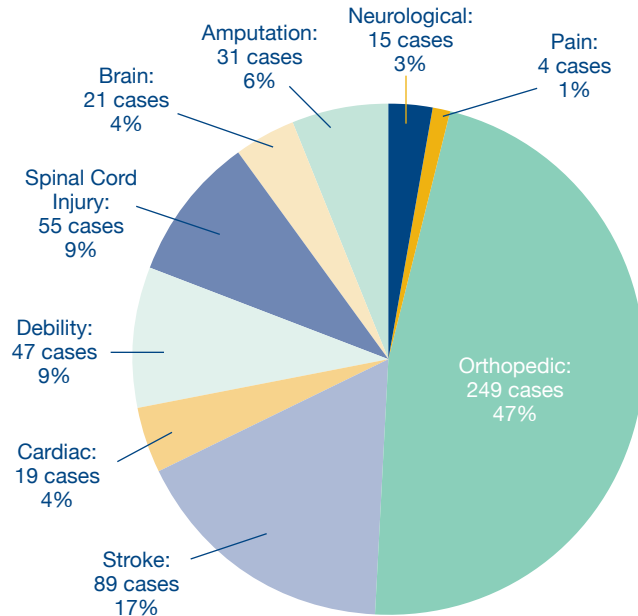

Inpatient Services

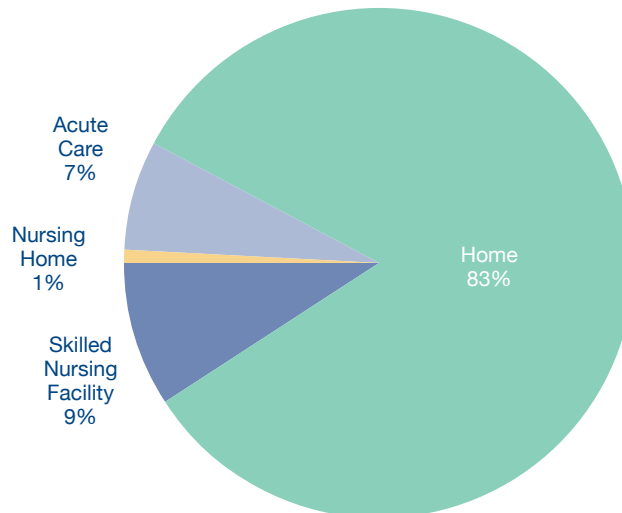
Ochsner Inpatient Rehabilitation Services provides an environment which assists individuals with physical impairments and disabilities resulting from illness or injury to reach maximal functional independence and return into the community. Services are provided for more than 500 patients per year who have experienced strokes, joint replacements, amputations, brain injuries, other orthopedic/neurological conditions, and general rehabilitation needs.

If we are unable to meet the needs of a patient, our team will recommend alternative services. We do not treat patients who are not medically stable, patients on ventilators, patients under the age of 17, or patients demonstrating the inability to progress in therapy due to significant cognitive impairments.

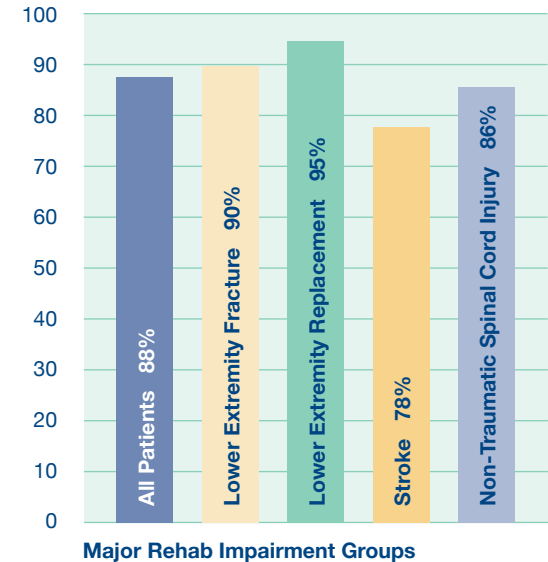
Patient Mix by Diagnosis
